Policy of Gomselmash

Regarding the Processing of Cookies

1. General Provisions

1.1.

Cookies are text files stored in the browser of a user's computer (mobile device) when visiting the corporate website of Gomselmash — gomselmash.by, as well as the websites of its branches: gzsito.by, mashinostroitel.by, dk.gomselmash.by (hereinafter referred to as the "Websites"). Cookies are used to record the actions performed by the user and allow the user not to re-enter or reselect the same parameters when revisiting the Websites.

1.2.

The purpose of processing cookies is to ensure convenience for users of the Websites (hereinafter referred to as "Users") and to improve the quality of the Websites' functionality.

1.3.

The Websites use cookies and similar technologies to provide information that matches Users' interests and needs, as well as to collect statistical and marketing information for analysis and improvement of the Websites. By using the Websites, the User confirms consent to the use of cookies and agrees to this Policy. If the User does not agree to the use of such files, the User must adjust browser settings accordingly or refrain from using these Websites.

1.4.

By visiting the Websites, the User agrees that Gomselmash may use cookies and other data for processing by Google Analytics, Yandex.Metrica, and similar technologies.

1.5.

When viewing any page of the Websites, both the webpage itself and a cookie file are downloaded to the User's computer (mobile device), allowing identification of whether a specific computer (mobile device) and/or User has previously visited the Website.

1.6.

If cookies are blocked or deleted, Gomselmash cannot guarantee the correct functioning of the Websites in the User's browser.

2. Types of Cookies Used

2.1.

Gomselmash uses two types of cookies on the Websites: “session cookies” and “persistent cookies”.

Session cookies are temporary files deleted when the Websites are closed, meaning they exist only during the current session. However, if automatic session restoration is enabled in the browser, which is common, session cookies may remain stored as if the browser had never been closed.

Persistent cookies are deleted either by the User or automatically upon expiration of the storage period. The duration of storage depends on the specific cookie and browser settings.

2.2.

The following types of cookies are processed on the Websites:

- **Necessary cookies**
These cookies are required to ensure proper functioning of the Website and use of its features. Disabling them may reduce Website performance and make some components or services unavailable.
- **Statistical cookies**
These cookies store Website visit history to improve functionality, analyze User interaction with the Website, optimize content, and measure advertising campaign effectiveness by providing information such as the number of Users, duration of visits, errors encountered, etc.
- **Functional cookies**
These cookies remember returning Users, their individual settings (for example, country/region), and preferences, helping personalize Website content and improve usability.
- **Advertising cookies**
These cookies determine which websites Users visited, how often they visited them, and which links they selected, allowing the display of advertisements relevant to Users’ interests.

3. Cookie Management

3.1.

Most User browsers are configured to automatically accept cookies. Users may change browser settings to block cookies or receive warnings when such files are sent to the device. There are several ways to manage cookies. More information can be found in the browser instructions explaining how to adjust or modify browser settings.

Some browsers also offer an “Incognito” mode that limits the amount of stored information and automatically deletes session cookies. In addition, Users may delete previously stored cookies using the appropriate browser history option.

3.2.

If the User configures their computer (mobile device) to completely reject cookies, the User may still visit the Websites. However, Website functionality may be significantly limited, including lack of access to certain features and/or webpages.

If the User uses multiple devices and/or browsers to access the internet, settings must be adjusted separately on each of them.

4. Amendments to the Cookie Processing Policy

4.1.

Gomselmash may update this Cookie Processing Policy as necessary, including to reflect changes in the cookies used or due to operational, legal, or regulatory reasons.

4.2.

Amendments to the Cookie Processing Policy become effective upon publication of the updated version on the Websites. Continued use of the Websites after such amendments constitutes the User’s acceptance of the revised Policy.
